PAYMENTS ON THE AGRICULTURE INTELLIGENCE SYSTEM PROJECT PHASE 1

Main Points

What we examined?

Payments on the Agriculture Intelligence System (AIS) Project Phase 1 by the Malaysian Agricultural Research and Development Institute (MARDI). The AIS Project Phase 1 was developed to facilitate stakeholders in the supply chain networking through Information and Communication Technology (ICT) under the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Industries (MAFI).

Why it is important?

 To determine whether the payments on AIS Project Phase 1 have been implemented in accordance with applicable laws, financial regulations and terms of agreement.

What we found?

- The audit findings are as follows:
 - payment of RM0.95 million were made out of the contract period (improper payment);
 - late penalty reduction of RM0.51 million due to delays in document review and the disruption of cloud services; and
 - the AIS Project Phase 1 worth RM8.87 million has not been used since November 2020 despite the completed project was handed over on 1st February 2020.

What do we recommend?

- The audit recommendations are as follows:
 - ensure the project is implemented within the stipulated period as per agreement to avoid out of contract payment;

- ensure calculation for late penalty formula on ICT procurement is in accordance with Government regulations so that claims are made in an orderly manner and comply with the agreement clauses;
- ensure effective monitoring on project management by taking immediate actions on problems arosed; and
- ensure that the system is fully utilised to prevent wastage incurred by the Government.
